

BAD BEAT Quad 2's OR BETTER

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The Bad Beat shall apply to the game of Texas Hold'Em only. "Bad Beat" means quad 2's (2-2-2-2) hand or better that is beat by a higher ranking hand (e.g., quads 2's losing to four Jacks).
2. Players with qualifying hands must play to the end of the hand. Players exposing cards with action pending void the Bad Beat Jackpot.
3. The hand must go to a showdown (played to the end, where all cards have been dealt and players have completed betting and showed their cards to determine the winner) in order for the jackpot to be awarded
4. Players must play their hand independently. Any discussion of the prize during the playing of the hand will void qualifications for the Bad Beat Jackpot. If any player, whether directly involved in the hand, passes information or instructs another on how to act or reveals his/her hand to other players, the Bad Beat Jackpot will be disqualified.
5. In order for a hand to be eligible to qualify for a Bad Beat, the pot must meet a minimum of \$40.00
6. A minimum of six players must be seated and dealt in at the beginning of the hand in order to qualify for the Bad Beat. (Other player minimums may apply.)
A Bad Beat shall apply to only the first natural five community cards dealt.
7. To qualify for the Bad Beat Jackpot, a player must have quad 2's (2-2-2-2) or better beaten.
 - Each eligible player will be paid out as per rule #11.
 - Any qualifying hand must use both hole cards.

8. A \$2 maximum amount will be removed from each pot according to rule #2. If it is a rake game, the \$20.00 or more includes the rake. In order for a hand to be eligible for the Bad Beat Jackpot, the pot must meet the minimum requirement for the game limit.
9. The Bad Beat Jack pot will start at 0.00
10. Beat Jackpot will then start to accrue daily from the No limit Texas hold em Poker cash game.
11. Wind River Casino may change the distribution percentages.
12. If a hand finishes with 3 qualifying hands, the lowest hand will only receive a player's share of the jackpot (e.g. four eights, four queens and queen high straight flush are dealt in the same hand. The Bad Beat hand will be the four queens and the winning hand will be the queen high straight flush.)
13. Management reserves the right eligibility of all qualifying hands. There will be no recourse if the cards are mucked before surveillance was able to verify the hands and community cards. Poker management will not be permitted to reconstruct the hands in any way.
14. 10% of the bad beat rake will go to administrative costs. 20% will seed the next jackpot. 70% will go directly to the current bad beat jackpot.
15. In order to collect any Wind River Casino Bad Beat payout, proper identification will be required. Payouts of the Bad Beat Jackpot are as follows:
 - 50% of the Bad Beat Jackpot will be awarded to the Bad Beat hand (losing hand).
 - 20% of the Bad Beat Jackpot will be awarded to the winner of the hand.

- 30% of the Bad Beat Jackpot will be awarded equally among the balance of the seated players on the game who received cards at the beginning of the hand.

16. A player who revokes his/her chips from the game prior to a showdown on a hand where a Bad Beat is won, forfeits his/her right to any prize money.

17. A player who walks away from the game, but leaves his/her chips on the table AND he/she was in the hand at the beginning, will retain rights to his/her share of the Bad Beat Jackpot if a Bad Beat hand occurs.

18. Players not dealt in at the start of the hand will not be eligible for a percentage of the Bad Beat Jackpot

19. Winners will be solely responsible for all taxes.

20. Players must have valid ID and produce a valid social security number in order to collect winnings

21. Prizes won are final. No substitution or transfer of prize permitted.

22. In the rare occurrence of a Bad Beat Jackpot being hit on more than one game at the same time, surveillance will be contacted to determine what table dealt cards first that table is the actual winner then the jackpot will be distributed on each game according to the percentages set in Rule #12 above.

23. Decisions of the Supervisor are final and without recourse.

24. By participating in the Wind River Casino Bad Beat Jackpot, winners consent to the use of their names and photographs for promotional purposes without additional compensation.

25. In the event of a tie, Bad Beat Jackpot hands (either tied losing hands or tied winning hands) at the same table, the Bad Beat Jackpot payouts awarded as

per rule #11 will be shared evenly between all players with the tie losing or tie winning hands.

26. In the event of multiple qualifying Bad Beat Jackpot hands (losing hands) the highest of the qualifying hands will be considered the loser, thereby winning the Bad Beat Jackpot payout as per rule #12.

27. Tournament hands do not qualify for the Bad Beat Jackpot

28. If the inspection of the deck fails, the hand will not qualify and the bad beat will be disqualified.

29. Once the pot reaches \$50,000.00 the requirements for the bad beat will drop to Aces full of Jacks

30. The Jackpot amount shall be updated daily at 5:00pm

31. Employees of the Wind River Casino are ineligible for the Bad Beat Jackpot

32. Players with no IDs will be given 12 hours to provide one. If none is provided within 12 hours the money will be put back into the pot.
